He was preceded in death by his mother, Lizzie Mae Yarbrough Hardwick; and brothers, Bill Pitts and Hank Hardwick.

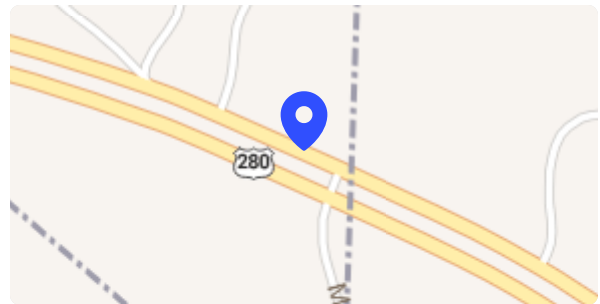

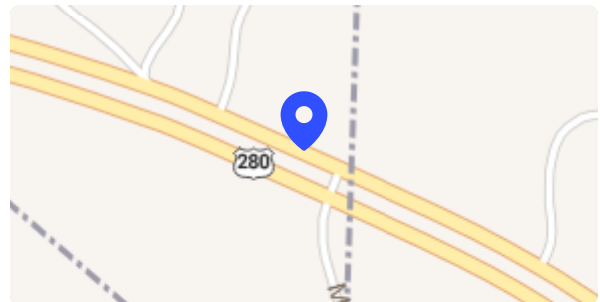

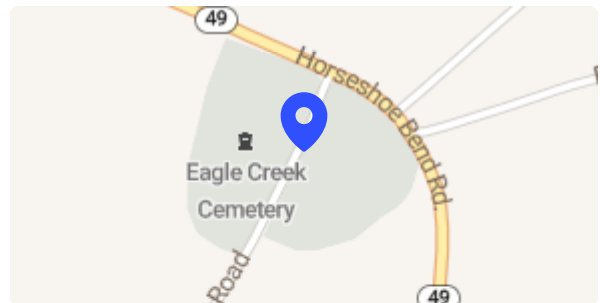
