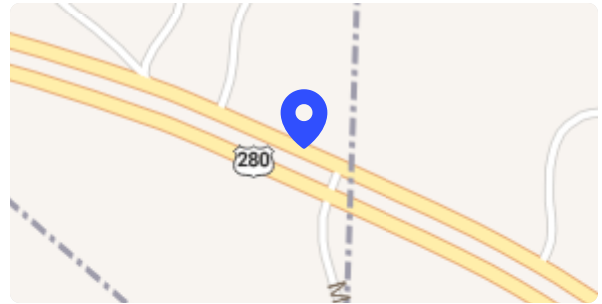
She was preceded in death by her parents, Jack and Bernice Whittle.

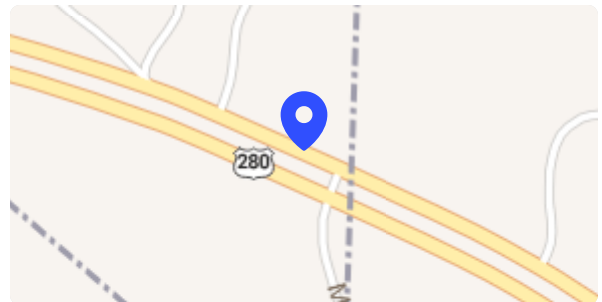
