Larry O'Neal Petty passed away on Tuesday, May 6, 2025, at Lake Martin Community Hospital. Born on April 7, 1938, he was the son of Mr. John Wesley Petty, Sr. and Mrs. Annie Pearl Whitman Petty. 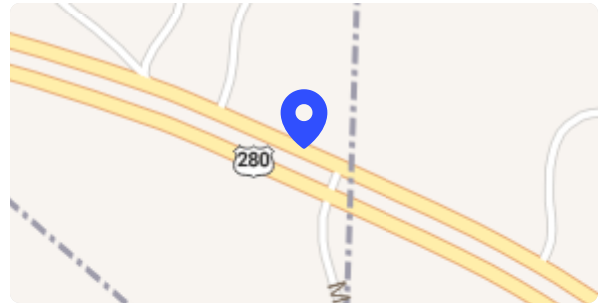

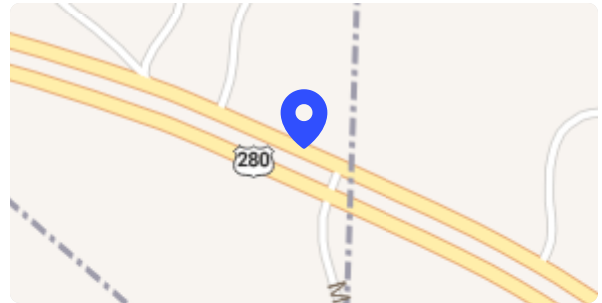

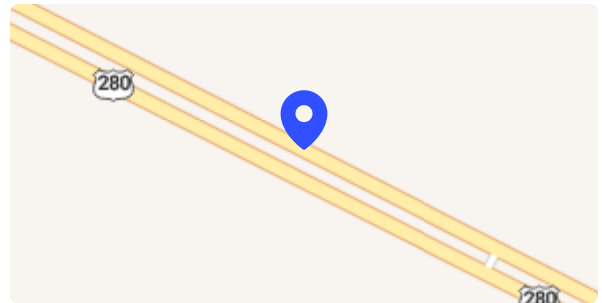
